Required Courses for all Greenhouse Workers, Supervisors, and PIs

Required	Frequency
Greenhouse Safety Fundamentals	3 years
Fire Safety and Fire Extinguisher Training	Annually
Heat Related Illnesses	Annually
Worker Protection Standard Training	Annually
Emergency Response Guide Video	3 years

An in-person Greenhouse Safety Fundamentals training is offered at the beginning of the spring semester of every year for all greenhouse users. This is comparable to the online Greenhouse Safety Fundamentals training.

Greenhouse users are strongly encouraged to complete any of the appropriate courses listed below based on their research needs.
