

Iowa State University Waste and Recycling Guide for Farms

EH&S COLLECTS

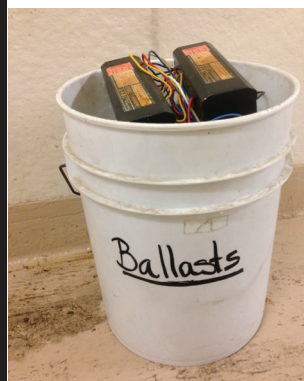
FARM DELIVERS



OIL:

Large quantities of oil must be collected on site in drums or tanks for collection by EH&S or Iowa State University's used oil vendor.

Small quantities of oil will be collected by EH&S. Label containers as "USED OIL."



BALLASTS:

Accumulate lighting ballasts in a drum.

Label the drum "BALLASTS."



OIL FILTERS:

Puncture, hot drain, and collect oil filters in a drum or bucket for EH&S collection.

Label the oil filter container "DRAINED-USED OIL FILTERS."



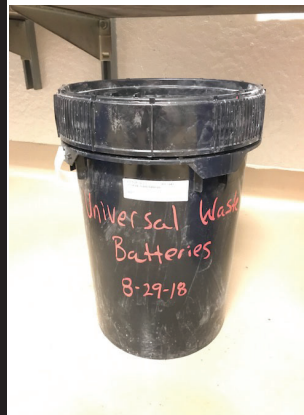
LAMPS:

Unwanted fluorescent lamps and high intensity discharge bulbs must be accumulated in closed packages (so the bulbs can't fall out if tipped), labeled "UNIVERSAL WASTE-LAMPS", and marked with the DATE the first unwanted lamp was placed in the box.



PESTICIDES:

EH&S will collect unwanted or expired herbicides and pesticides.



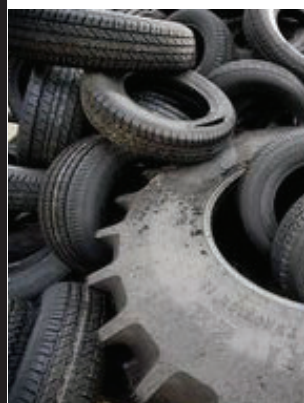
BATTERIES:

Collect unwanted lead acid, lithium, and nickel cadmium-batteries in a container with a lid labeled "UNIVERSAL WASTE-BATTERIES" and be sure to write the DATE on the drum when the first battery was placed inside of that container. *Alkaline batteries may be discarded in the trash.*



CHEMICALS:

EH&S will collect all unwanted chemicals to include aerosol cans and basic household cleaners.



TIRES:

Used tires should be exchanged when purchasing new ones, or you may ask your local tire retailer/service station if they accept used tires for recycling.

When in doubt, ship it out with EH&S.
