Attached is the severe weather evacuation plan for Black Engineering.

The ground floor hallway on the south side of the building (outside of Rooms 0066-0095 Black) has been designated as the meeting place for occupants of Black – NOTE: if there is a large crowd we can go into 0086 Black and some of the ME interior rooms along that hallway. When there is a severe weather alert the weather coordinator will e-mail and call the severe weather assistants. In turn, they will alert all people in Black according to the designated area as color coded on the attached.

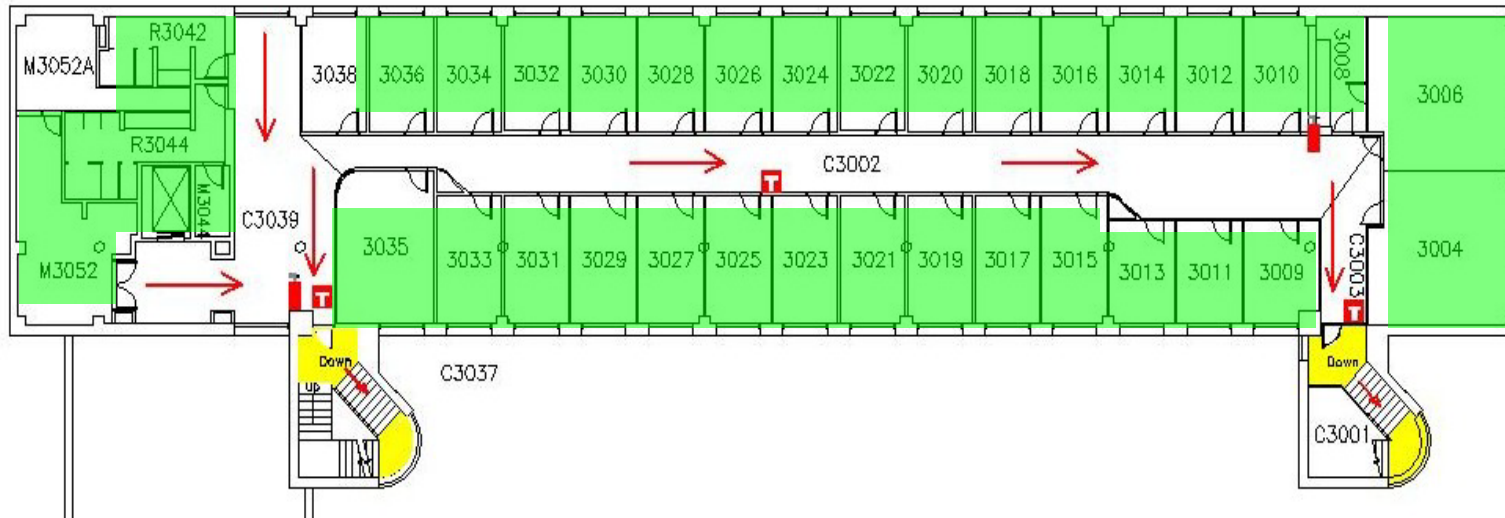
