

Severe Weather Notification Procedures For Gerdin Business Building



Emergency Shelters in Event of Tornado:

Ground Floor: Classrooms **0129, 0119, 0115**; Team Rooms **0163, 0167, 0169**; Student Org Room **0165**; Storage Area **0211**; Custodial Area **0213**; Restrooms **0176, 0172**

First Floor: **Stark Lecture Hall (1148)**; Classrooms **1117, 1127**; Restrooms **1176, 1172**

Second Floor: **None**

Third Floor: **None**

Procedures:

The weather coordinators for the building in 1200 Gerdin (Sonja Foley) or 2200 Gerdin (Kay Palan) will sound the Tornado Alarm upon issuance of a Tornado Warning for Ames by the National Weather Service heard upon the Weather Radios in those locations or actual tornado sighting on campus. Each floor should use the following procedure plan accordingly:

Ground Floor:

Those in the Northeast Wing will exit their rooms and proceed in an orderly fashion to the Team Rooms 0163, 0167, 0169; Student Org Room 0165; Storage Area 0211; Custodial Area 0213; Restrooms 0176, 0172

Students and faculty in the South Wing are to go to Classrooms 0115, 0119, 0129, or the lower level of the Stark Lecture Hall 1148.

First Floor:

Occupants will exit their rooms in an orderly fashion and proceed to the Stark Lecture Hall (1148), classrooms 1117, 1127, or the Restrooms.

Second Floor:

Occupants will exit their rooms in an orderly fashion and proceed to either the Stark Lecture Hall (1148).

Third Floor:

Occupants will exit their rooms in an orderly fashion and proceed to any of the locations listed above.

NOTE: If you feel that conditions are right for the development of a tornado, do not wait for the Tornado Alarm to sound. Go to one of the locations mentioned above. Keep away from exterior doors and windows.
