Weather Notification Plan Animal Science Kildee Hall/Meat Lab

The Meat Lab Plans were developed separately and begin on page 4 of this document. Kildee Hall and Meat Lab plans may slightly overlap in the new section of Kildee.

Upon receipt of a weather alert via the weather radio, the following notification action will take place in Kildee Hall. Areas within the scope of Kildee Hall will be notified of impending bad weather. Areas will be notified of a severe thunderstorm warning, tornado watch, or tornado warning. Under severe thunderstorm warning and tornado watch conditions, notification will be given to office areas that severe weather is in the area via email and telephone lists. No further action will be taken. For a tornado warning, notification will include instructions to seek the appropriate shelter area.

Physical Notification

Kildee Hall Storm Shelter Floor Plan Instructions

These instructions are guidelines for the storm shelter areas of Kildee Hall.

Third Floor/original Kildee: Exit using north or south staircase to basement level, to area hallway A or B (north and west corridors).

Second Floor/original Kildee: Exit using north or south staircase to basement level to area hallway A or B (north and west corridors).

Second Floor/ Kildee Addition (2255 and 2356 hallways): Exit using the staircase to the north side of the building to ground level, enter research area hallway (Charles or other admin staff will be at north end of hall).

First Floor/original Kildee: Exit using north or south staircase to basement level to area Hallway C and D (south and east corridors).

First Floor/Kildee addition:

First Floor/Lush Audition (125 Kildee): Use back stairs from classroom to basement level, or exit to foyer area, across foyer and down stairs in southern corner of old Kildee Hall, to area hallway D and E (southern most corridors near Lush).

1204 Kildee Hall (Ensminger Room): Stay in the room, move to center, away from the doors.

1221 Kildee: Exit south staircase to basement level, to area hallway C or D or follow same instructions as group you notified.

Restricted research area: Exit from rooms into center hallway of restricted area.

2310 Kildee Hall: cross Pavilion floor to the general holding area hallway.

Weather Notification Plan Meat Lab

Upon receipt of a weather alert via the weather radio, the follow notification action will take place. Areas with in the scope of the Meat Lab will be notified of impending bad weather. Areas will be notified of a severe thunderstorm warning, tornado watch, or tornado warning. Under severe thunderstorm warning and tornado watch conditions, notification will be given to office areas that severe weather is in the area. No further action will be taken. For a tornado warning, notification will include instructions to seek the appropriate shelter area.

The following is the set guidelines for notification.

Phone Calls

- 1. Randy Petersohn (294-5321) or Deb Michel (294-1187) in Room 194 Meat Lab will be responsible to alert individuals in that area.
- 2. Ardella Krull (294-9151) in 215 Meat Lab will be notified and responsible to alert individuals in that area.
- 3. Marcia King-Brink or Elaine Larson (294-2166) will be notified and responsible to alert those in that area.
- 4. The graduate student office (294-1548) will be notified.
- 5. Gloria Lantz (294-4405) at 2275 Kildee (Meat Lab Addition) will be notified and responsible for alerting the offices and labs in this area. If Gloria is not available, Steven Lonergan (294-9126) will be notified.
- 6. Steve Niebuhr (294-4663) will be notified and be responsible for alerting his area.

Physical Notification

This action involves walking to areas with the Meat Lab and alerting individuals of a tornado warning. These areas include:

- 1. 160 Meat Lab
- 2. 137 Meat Lab
- 3. 163 Meat Lab
- 4. 133 Meat Lab
- 5. 152 Meat Lab

Rooms 163 and 133 are classrooms. Faculty or staff members will be responsible to make sure students or visitors go to the appropriate storm shelter area.

Note: If the weather coordinator is gone, the weather radio will be transferred to 194 Meat Lab. All notification responsibilities will be moved to a designated individual there.

There are 2 additional weather radios located in 215 Meat Lab (Ardella) and 2292 Kildee (Steve Niebuhr). These radios are to assist in notification, but still main notification will originate from 194 and 182 Meat Lab.

Meat Lab Storm Shelter Floor Plan Instructions

These instructions are guidelines to reach a designated storm shelter area and reading the floor plan.

First Floor Meat Lab

- 1. Routes to storm shelter areas are marked by red arrow.
- 2. Follow appropriate route to shelter area A, B, or C.
 - A) In hallway by 165 Meat lab to 137 Meat Lab.
 - B) In hallway by 121 Meat Lab (between bathrooms)
 - C) Small hallway by door 1290 Kildee and 164 Meat Lab (between overhead door of sales dock and atrium door).

Second Floor - Meat Lab

- 1. Follow routes marked by red arrows.
- 2. Proceed to first floor Meat Lab to point B by 121 Meat Lab (between bathrooms)

Second Floor – Meat Lab/Kildee Addition

(includes rooms 2271 – 2378Kildee)

- 1. Follow routes marked by red arrows.
- 2. Proceed to first floor Meat Lab or Kildee.
- 3. Move to point C or D. Point D is located by 1287 Kildee (Metabolism Room).
- 4. If at point C, make sure that door for 1290 is closed.

Shelter areas A, B, C, and D afford reasonable protection. They are away from outside windows and doors, tall ceilings, are close to inner support, and near emergency lighting.

When proceeding to shelter areas:

- 1. Move quickly, but in a reasonable manner. Running can create falls with injuries or trampling of others.
- 2. Remain calm.
- 3. Once to shelter area, remain standing close to the wall and remain calm.
- 4. You will be notified when you can return to your work area or exit the building.
