OFF-CAMPUS INJURY

STEP ONE

If the injury or event leading to the **injury is significant, call <u>911</u>**.

Notify your department or supervisor about the off-campus injury.

If non-life threatening and care is needed see the QR code below for approved medical providers.

STEP TWO

Complete an ISU Incident Report via ISU Incident Portal within 24 hours.

Click "Report a New Incident" and select "Click here to report an injury to an employee."

ON-CAMPUS INJURY

— STEP ONE —

If it is LIFE-THREATENING

Call **911.**

Ensure the scene is safe.

If TRAINED, perform <u>first aid</u>.

If it is NON-LIFE-THREATENING

Business Hours

Option 2: (For <u>First Aid</u> Only) ISU Occupational Medicine, (515) 294-2056, treats minor work related injuries or conditions.
