

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS

ON-CAMPUS INJURY

STEP ONE

If it is LIFE-THREATENING

Call 911

Perform first aid if TRAINED and the scene is safe.

If it is NON-LIFE-THREATENING

Business Hours

Go to Thielen Student Health Center.

After Hours

Go to Mary Greeley Medical Center Emergency Room or follow up with primary care physician.

STEP TWO

Complete an ISU Incident Report via ISU Incident Portal within 24 hours.

Click "Report a New Incident" and select "Click here to report an injury to a Non-Employee."

OFF-CAMPUS INJURY

STEP ONE

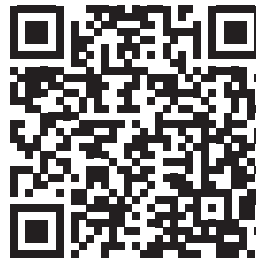
If the injury or event leading to the injury is significant, call 911.

If additional assistance and consultation is needed, call DPS (515) 294-4428.

STEP TWO

Complete an ISU Incident Report via ISU Incident Portal within 24 hours.

Click "Report a New Incident" and select "Click here to report an injury to a Non-Employee."

STEP ONE

Call 911.

STEP TWO

WITHOUT INJURIES
